

# The Princess Castle: Chateau Ribagnac

One for budding Sleeping Beauties everywhere – just look at this incredible chateau in the Limousin region (known as the French lake district) and you'll be transported straight into a storybook. Owned by a Franco-English couple, who have children themselves, this romantic castle has been converted into five *chambres d'hôtes* (the French version of a B&B) in a stylish mix of old and new.

Staying here is a brilliant way to experience country house living in an informal atmosphere – you won't need to worry about the kids running about.

Babies are well catered for, too. Apart from the standard equipment you might need, such as highchairs and baby baths, you can also get nappies, wipes, and even organic homemade baby food on request.

The chateau has 35 hectares of gardens, meadows and woodland, with stunning views across the valley, as well as a play area and nature trails. As for the surrounding countryside, there's water sports, cycling, riding and beautiful walks all within easy reach.
